Second Stop

Bring others to Him

Prayers

Pray for those experiencing racism, oppression, and injustice.

Pray for those feeling overwhelmed by loneliness.

Pray for those grieving the loss of a family or friend.

Third Stop

May His Kingdom come...

Stop and ask God for His Kingdom to come in our city as it is in heaven. Ask for His Justice and Righteousness to prevail.

Scripture

“For it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom.”

Luke 12:32b

“But let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!”

Prayers

Pray for healing and restoration for the homeless, struggling with mental health/addiction, past trauma.

Pray for love, grace, and mercy to develop between people groups that previously hated or avoided one another.

Pray that God would purge racism and prejudice in His people and our culture.

Fourth Stop

Invite the Holy Spirit to move

Stop and ask the Holy Spirit to move powerfully through the Church in our city. Ask for the glory and power of Jesus Christ to be revealed.
